Downloading (copying) images from your digital camera to your PC/MAC

Get To Know The PC OS

- **Images are files**
- **Camera and cards look like hard drives**
- **Develop a management strategy (folders)**
- **File Manager**
 - **Windows Explorer (thumbnail view)**
 - **FastStone Viewer, IrfanView, Picasa, XnView (free)**
 - **Editing Software (Photoshop, Corel, Camera software)**

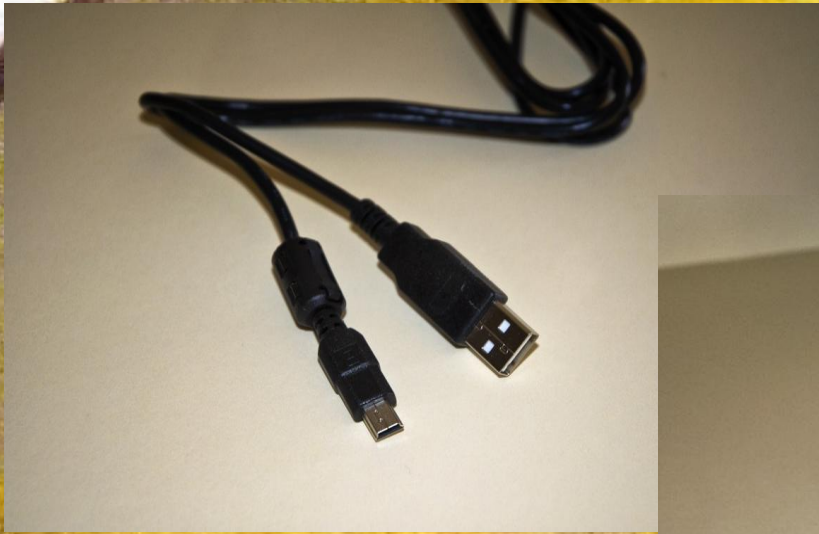
File Types

- **JPEG, JPG (most common; in camera processed; lossy; use highest resolution and quality)**
- **TIFF (not very common; in camera processed; loss-less)**
- **RAW (most detail; no processing; loss-less; need software to process)**

Connect Camera to PC

- **Read the Manual**
- **USB cord supplied with your camera**
- **Software supplied with your camera**
- **Locate source and destination**
- **Download (copy)**

Use Card Reader

- **Card reader (slots) on computer**
- **USB card reader**
- **Locate source and destination**
- **Download (copy)**

- **Create a picture CD**

Finish Up

- **Backup, backup, backup**
- **Erase (format) card (in camera) AFTER you confirm files have been copied**
- **Only edit copies, never the original**
- **Avoid JPEG with multiple edits and saves**
